STAY THE COURSE & LET GOD REFINE US INTO CHRIST'S IMAGE

A woman called a silversmith to make an appointment to watch him work. She was interested in the process of refining silver. As she watched the silversmith, he held a piece of silver over the fire and let it heat up. He explained that in refining silver, one needed to hold the silver in the middle of the fire where the flames were hottest so it can burn away all the impurities. The woman thought about the scripture: "He sits as a refiner and purifier of silver." She asked the silversmith if he had to sit in front of the fire the entire time. The man answered, "Yes, he not only had to sit there holding the silver but he had to keep his eyes on the silver the entire time it was in the fire. If the silver was left a moment too long in the flames, it would be destroyed." The woman was silent for a moment. Then she asked, "How do you know when the silver is fully refined?" He smiled at her and answered, "Oh, that's easy – when I see my image in it."

What a profound revelation for you and I! If today, you are feeling the heat of the fire, remember that God has His eye on you and will keep watching you until He sees Christ's image in you. I encourage you to stay on His course, don't lose hope, and accept the refinement and purification from our Master as He completes His good work in you.
